Privacy Policy

What follows is LINC's online privacy policy, which governs personal information gathered on our Internet site consistent with policy established by the LINC Board of Directors.

LINC's Commitment to Online Security

Physical, electronic and managerial procedures have been employed to safeguard the security and integrity of personal information. All LINC staff, volunteers, and contractors with access to personal information obtained on LINC's web sites are also bound to adhere to this policy.

Personal Information that LINC May Collect Online

LINC, Inc. collects personal information online, including names, postal and e-mail addresses, phone and facsimile numbers and complaint information. LINC does not knowingly collect or maintain any personal information from children under the age of 18.

How LINC Uses Personal Information Collected Online

Unless you otherwise consent, we will use your personal information only for the purpose for which it is submitted, such as to reply to your emails, handle your complaints, business requests related to program participation, and we will use such information to provide program updates, in program record-keeping and to conduct surveys. Our survey results may be published but will not result in the reporting or publication of any personal information provided to us. At certain points where personal information is collected on our site, there may be a box where you may indicate you would like to be on a mailing list to receive information about other LINC programs and services and about ways to support LINC. This election box only appears in places where the department collecting personal information maintains such lists. At any time you can add or remove your name from a LINC list by contacting us at unsubscribe@lincinc.org.

Computer Tracking and Cookies

Our Web sites are not set up to track, collect or distribute personal information not submitted by visitors. A cookie is a small amount of data that is sent to your browser from a Web server and stored on your computer's hard drive. LINC uses non-identifying cookies to provide easier site navigation and access to forms. You can still use LINC sites if your browser is set to reject cookies. Our cookies do not generate personal data, do not read personal data from your machine and

are never tied to anything that could be used to identify you.
